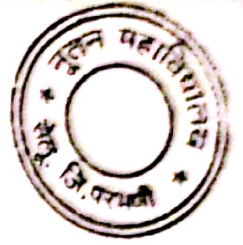
8. Awareness Programs:


- Organizing awareness campaigns, workshops, seminars, and discussions to sensitize the entire campus community about the negative impact of ragging.
