

- ii. College Level ELCs have been established for New Voters who are aged between 18-21 year.
- iii. Organization of Chunav Pathshalas at Polling Station wise and BLOs are make in-charge of Chunav Pathshala to educate the non college gone people.
- iv. - Concept of voter awareness forum (VAF) has been developed to spread voter awareness amongst employees of Govt./Pvt. Department/Organization.

VIII. Technology Integration:


Leverage technology to educate students on online voter registration, electronic voting systems, and the role of social media in shaping electoral discourse.

X. Community Outreach:


Extend the impact beyond the college campus by engaging in community outreach programs, collaborating with local organizations, and spreading electoral literacy in surrounding areas.


