



Bhoomi Pujan Ceremony by the auspicious hands of Mr. Shankarraoji Chavan

**First Decade (1968 – 1977)** : The college shifted to its present location on 15<sup>th</sup> June 1970. The *Bhoomi Pujan* Ceremony of Nutan Mahavidyalaya's building had been done by the auspicious hands of Hon. Shankarraoji Chavan the then Minister of Rural Development in the Ministry of Govt. of Maharashtra. Late Swami Ramanand Teerth was one of the inspiring personalities, who regularly guided us from the bottom to top of the institute and he had been the special person who visited this campus. One student achieved the honour of entering in the merit list in the **first academic year of the college** and there were four students in the merit list of the University. The National Service Scheme had been initiated in the year 1969 in India and in the first year itself the college got the honor of introducing a unit of the National Service Scheme. The Government of Maharashtra sanctioned Sports Talent Scholarship to the college students. The college performed its responsibility for developing in the *educand* a sense of responsibility towards society and ethical values in Selu Taluka. The college voluntarily participated in National Adult Education Program of Government of India. In the first decade the college has carved out the iconic face of education not only in the confined field of education but also started to practice moral values in society.

**Second Decade: (1977-1987)** : The Government of Maharashtra has adopted the New Pattern of Education i.e. 10+2+3 in the year 1975. The first batch of H.S.C. passed out in 1977. Four students were in the Merit list of HSC Board. Two students stood in the merit list of University. Dalitmitra Shiramji Bhangdiya Boys Hostel was constructed as a part of diamond jubilee. The hostel was especially constructed for economically backward students with intake capacity of 80 students. The team of Table Tennis, Kho-kho and Kabbadi achieved success at Maharashtra Level. The college has also undertaken the Projects of Sericulture and Teak Wood successfully. The college launched the program of Educational Quality Enhancement in the year 1985 and now it is popularly known as Selu Pattern. Summer Vacation Classes, Intensive Teaching, 24 X 7 classes are being conducted in this program. The then Principal Mr. D.R. Kulkarni was honoured as Best Teacher by Government of Maharashtra.

**Fourth Decade (1997-2007)** : With the need of an independent set up for Library, the college constructed Library Building & Reading Room with the help of UGC funding. The college, in order to know its strengths, weaknesses and opportunities through informed review process, has undergone the Accreditation process of NAAC in the year 2003. In the year 2005, the college NSS Unit and NSS Officer Mr. R.M. Jaibhaya was honoured by Government of Maharashtra as "Best NSS Unit" and "Best Programme Officer Award". In the year 2006, the college library and office was fully computerized.

**Fourth Decades** : Accreditation of National Assessment is done. Library building was constructed with the help of UGC 8<sup>th</sup> Plan. NSS unit of College honoured with excellent NSS Unit of Maharashtra. Fully computerization of Office and library in aid available in this decade.

**Fifth Decade (2007-2017)** : Swami Ramanand Teerth Marathwada University, Nanded honoured the college with "Best College Award" in the year 2007-2008. One student stood first at the University Examination in English Compulsory Subject. Taking into consideration the need of protected home for girls, the college constructed well equipped "Womens' Hostel" with the help of UGC funds. The college has undergone the 2<sup>nd</sup> Cycle of Accreditation Process by NAAC. The college successfully conducted "Prerana Youth Festival" of SRTM University, Nanded in the year 2010. The college hosted successfully conducted the Avishkar Research Festival in the year 2015. The teachers and students have represented in 'Avikshkar Research Festival' and got various prizes. The "Prerana" students' magazine received nearly 13 prizes from SRTM University, Nanded and Yeshwantrao Chavan Pratishthan, Mumbai.
