
2. Objectives

- Travel permits and essential worker documents were verified to ensure compliance with government regulations.


Preventive Measures and Awareness:

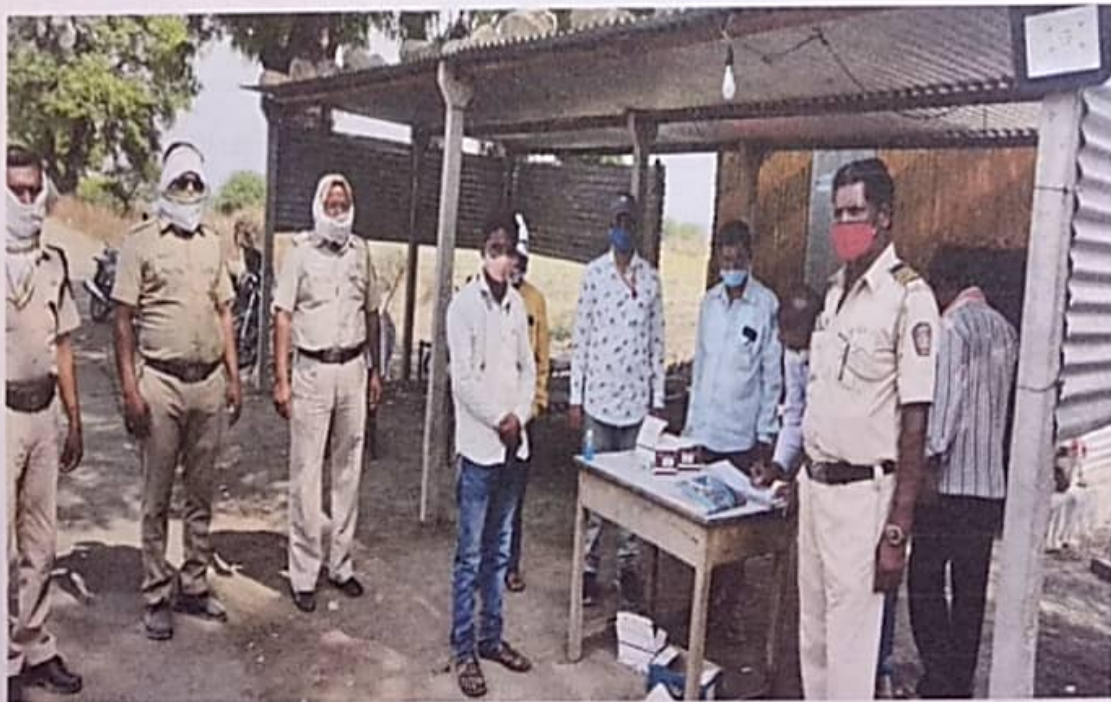
