



## Activity Report: Blood Donation Camp at Nutan Mahavidyalaya Selu

**Date:** 07/12/2018


**Location:** Nutan Mahavidyalaya, Selu, District Parbhani

trained medical personnel, ensuring a safe and comfortable experience for all donors.



During the event, 45 students successfully donated blood. The turnout reflected a strong commitment among the students to contribute to a vital cause and help save lives.


