- Support local artisans: To contribute to the economic empowerment of rural communities
  by encouraging the purchase of Khadi products, thereby supporting the livelihood of
  local artisans who produce them.





## Rationale:

- Nutan Mahavidyalaya Selu, with its rich heritage linked to the Indian Freedom Struggle
  and its logo depicting Gandhiji, takes immense pride in promoting Gandhian philosophy.
   This Khadi Mela is an outreach extension activity aimed at:
- Motivating and inspiring the college community and residents of Selu to embrace Khadi cloth, a symbol of self-reliance advocated by Mahatma Gandhi.
- Highlighting the importance of Gandhian values such as simplicity, self-sufficiency, and swadeshi (patronizing domestic products).

#### **Activities:**

- Cultural Performances: Students from [College Name] and Nutan Vidyalaya Selu can
  present cultural performances based on patriotic songs, skits depicting the importance of

- A rise in sales of Khadi products, supporting local artisans and promoting self-reliance.
- Strengthening the bond between the college and the local community.
