3. Student Engagement:

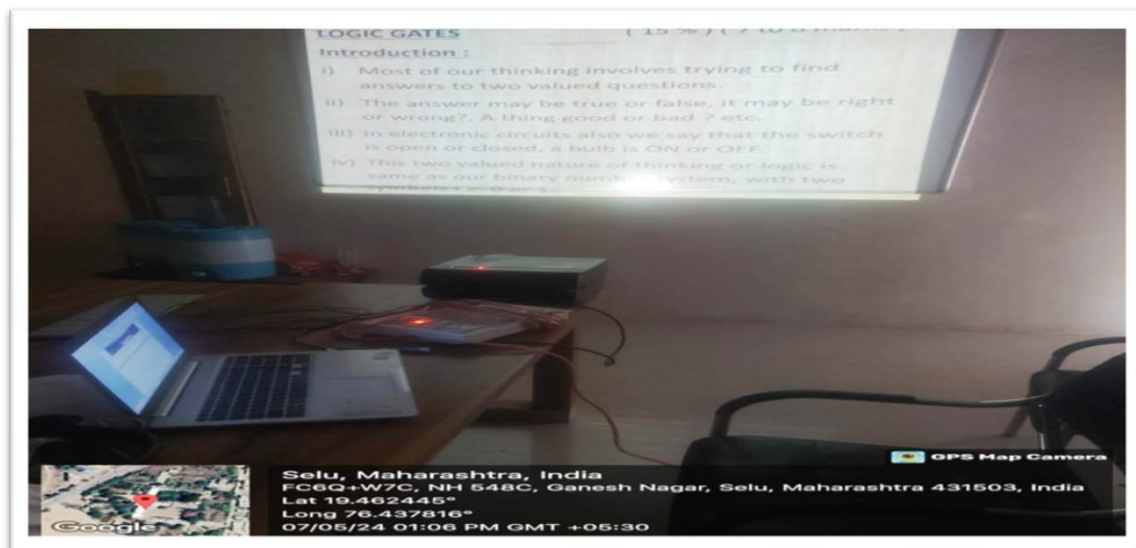
- Students will receive training on using ICT tools effectively.
