Details of Activity:

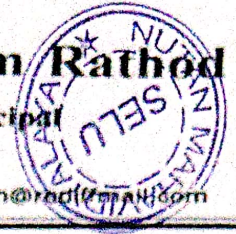
Date: September 10th, 2018


These interactive sessions fostered a spirit of collaboration and nurtured a love for learning among the participants.
