Jijabai’s Love for Dharma and Patriotism:

- Jijabai’s upbringing in a tumultuous era fueled her intense patriotism.
- She witnessed the humiliation of Hindus by foreign invaders and developed a strong hatred towards them.
- Post-marriage, Jijabai’s love for Dharma united two warring clans—the Bhosales and the Jadhavs—against the invaders.
- She urged both families to rise above personal ego and fight for the establishment of a Hindu Kingdoml.

Protecting Swaraj: Jijabai’s Role:

- During the siege of Panhala fort, when Shivaji Maharaj was trapped for four months, Jijabai shouldered the responsibility of Swaraj.


Conclusion:
