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Late Swami Ramanand Teerth, the renowned leader of Hyderabad Freedom Struggle and the ex M.P. of the region, inspired the local freedom activists to establish an institution to impart national education to the local students in their mother tongue and as a result, our institution Nutan Vidyalaya Shikshan Sanstha was established. After Independence, the institution grew into a big academic institution committed to the social cause and the restructuring and development of the nation. The institution has been engaged in these pursuits since then. Some of such programmes are...

- 1) National Relief Fund to help displaced people due to National Calamities.
- 2) Tree Plantation Programme (vana Mahostava).
- 3) Mahatma Gandhi Birth centenary celebrations, especially in rural areas.
- 4) Eradication of illiteracy etc.

Teachers, parents, students, alumni meetings are regularly arranged for establishing living contact with them and also to develop the second leadership. Late Shriramji Bhangdiya who served as President /Secretary of the Sanstha for the period of more than 25 years, was honoured by the Govt. of Maharashtra as "Dalit Mitra" by the hands of Vice-President of India. Therefore apt word for him is, Architect of the Sanstha.
